Security Camera Upgrade and Installation –RFP 15-08 Addendum #1

Below are responses to questions that were received in accordance with the requirements in the original RFP documents.

- 1. Is there a basis-of-design for the CCTV cameras and recording equipment listed in the scope-of-services? If so, what brand/manufacture was used as the basis-of-design?**
No, as long as it covers the scope of functionality listed with the system, no certain brand is required.
- 2. Are there any layout drawings available that show the preferred locations for cameras and other equipment? If so, can electronic copies be obtained?**
No, at the mandatory pre-bid meeting, you will have the ability to see all locations and where the cameras should be placed
- 3. Who is responsible for installation of underground conduit, weatherproof enclosures and other raceways required?**
The company that wins the bid will be responsible for the installation and materials required
- 4. With respect to the evaluation criteria listed on Page 10: Is there a weighting assigned to each individual criteria? Also – please clarify the phrase, “Perceived structural integrity.”**
This particular item is more of generalization for all of our contracts and does not directly pertain to this project as there will not be any buildings/structures involved
- 5. Finally, are you expecting written proposals with a detailed design of the proposed system, including specification sheets and drawings?**
No, the only thing required would be pictures of the types of cameras and possible example of the quality picture the cameras can capture
